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3 **Subject: A MATTER-SPECIFIC WAIVER OF ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE**  
4 **SECTION 1.15.130A., RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT AFTER**  
5 **LEAVING MUNICIPAL SERVICE, TO WILLIAM D. FALSEY.**  
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8 William D. Falsey began working at the Municipality of Anchorage on July 6, 2015 as the  
9 Municipal Attorney. Mr. Falsey was appointed Municipal Manager on October 15, 2017. Mr.  
10 Falsey left municipal service on December 1, 2020.

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12 During his time as the Municipal Attorney, Mr. Falsey opined, including by letters written in  
13 March and April 2016, that a public prescriptive easement exists over the "Stewart  
14 Homestead Road." A private non-profit, Friends of the Stewart Public Trail, Inc. is currently  
15 seeking judicial confirmation that the public prescriptive easement exists in the case:  
16 *Friends Of The Stewart Public Trail Inc. vs. Pugh Jr, Franklin D et al* (3AN-19-05746CI).  
17 The Friends of the Stewart Public Trail, Inc. wishes to retain Mr. Falsey's services in  
18 connection with the ongoing litigation.

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20 Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 1.15.130A provides that "An employee who leaves  
21 municipal service may not, for one year after leaving municipal service, represent, advise,  
22 or assist a person for compensation regarding a matter that was under consideration by the  
23 administrative unit served by the employee, if the municipal employee participated  
24 personally and substantially in the matter through the exercise of official action." The Code  
25 further defines "matter" to include "a case, proceeding, application, contract, or  
26 determination ... ."

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28 The Municipality is not, and never has been, a party to the ongoing litigation, but the letters  
29 Mr. Falsey issued as Municipal Attorney are referred to in the pleadings.  
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31 Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 1.15.130B permits the Assembly to waive  
32 application of 1.15.130A "upon determination that a proposed action by a former employee  
33 is not adverse to the public interest." In this case, by acceptance of this memorandum the  
34 Assembly finds that it would not be adverse to the public interest for Mr. Falsey to represent,  
35 advise or assist the Friends of the Stewart Public Trail, Inc., prior to December 1, 2021. To  
36 the extent the restriction set out in AMC subsection 1.15.130A. would limit Mr. Falsey's  
37 ability to represent, advise or assist the Friends of the Stewart Public Trail, Inc. prior to  
38 December 1, 2021, the Assembly hereby waives the restriction.
