Subject: AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE.

SECTION 10.50.035D.4 TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR THE MUNICIPAL CLERK TO PROVIDE QUARTERLY BAR

SAFETY HOUR REPORTS.

The Bar Safety Hour Permit Program, as authorized by AO 2013-86(S) and first initiated August 16, 2013, encourages eligible licensed establishments throughout the Municipality of Anchorage to engage in mitigating the impact of bar closing hour by remaining open additional time on weekends without alcohol sale and service, under the Bar Safety Hour Permit Program. The Bar Safety Hour Permit Program is administered by the Municipal Clerk's Office.

The Clerk's Office has been reporting on the compliance of participants of the Bar Safety Hour since August of 2013. Reports include citations, violations, notice of violations and other enforcement information from the Anchorage Police Department, Land Use Enforcement, and the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office enforcement. These reports have consistently shown that businesses participating in the safety hour have not had any violations of the regulations under Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) 10.50.035D.2.

At the July 14, 2022 Community and Economic Development Committee Meeting, the committee members, Assembly Members Petersen, Constant, Rivera, Allard, Cross, and Sulte, who are the sponsors of this ordinance, discussed the program and the need for the quarterly reporting. The Committee recognized the need for the Assembly to be kept informed of any concerns or issues with the participants of the program but did not see a need to continue receiving quarterly reports.

Because of the success of this program, the proposed ordinance updates the requirement in municipal code, section 10.50.035D.4 for the Municipal Clerk to provide reports to the Assembly only if violations of the bar safety hour occur, or annually, whichever comes first.
