A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY SETTING FORTH A PROCESS FOR REVIEWING ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.

WHEREAS, oversight and dialogues surrounding current Anchorage Police Department ("APD") policy is needed in a comprehensive way; and

WHEREAS, under Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.90.080 recently enacted by AO 2020-75, Anchorage Police Department policies and procedures are published online and updates to the policies and procedures will also be published; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Advisory Commission has a wide set of perspectives and experiences outside of current law enforcement officers which will allow for analysis of policies and procedures, including proposed changes and to ensure accessible public dialogue and understanding of the policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, changes to APD's policies and procedures can have significant impacts, including fiscal, on the operations of the Department; and

WHEREAS, these facilitated dialogues with community members, review by Public Safety Advisory Commission members, and presentation to the Assembly members ensures greater transparency and more opportunity to improve the policies and procedures the Anchorage Police Department abides by to maintain safety and security for all;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

<u>Section 1.</u> APD policy changes shall be forwarded to the Public Safety Advisory Commission for review and determination if additional public input and hearing is recommended. APD will endeavor to submit policy changes to the Commission prior to them becoming effective, whenever possible. The Commission shall produce a quarterly report to the Assembly's Public Safety Committee of the Whole presenting a summary of policy changes submitted by the Anchorage Police Department, including which policies the Commission recommends for additional review.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Assembly's Public Safety Committee of the Whole shall review all recommendations by the Commission at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

<u>Section 3.</u> Policies which the Committee deem require additional public review and hearing shall be set for the next Assembly meeting agenda by an AM on the consent agenda. Members may pull the item from the consent agenda and debate then vote, or choose to set for a public hearing any policy submitted by the

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3	Section 4. An Assembly member may request a review of an APD policy using
4	the above process by submitting the request in writing to the Chair of the Public
5	Safety Advisory Commission and copying the Chief of Police. A Commission
6	member may also request a review of an APD policy using the above process
7	through a procedure deemed appropriate by the Commission and ensuring that
8	notice of any policy under review is submitted in writing to the Chief of Police.
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0	Section 5. It is not the intent of this Resolution to require Assembly approval of
1	APD policies; it is the intent of this Resolution for the Assembly to determine when
12	additional public process on policy changes is required.
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4	Section 6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and
