1 **A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY REGARDING THE**  
2 **MAYOR'S ORDERS AND REGULATIONS ISSUED UNDER THE MAYOR'S**  
3 **PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY (COVID-19).**  
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6 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor issued a Proclamation of Emergency (COVID-19) under  
7 Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.80.080 on March 12, 2020 and since then has  
8 issued emergency orders and regulations to address it; and  
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10 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to AMC section 3.80.085, the Assembly may terminate  
11 individual emergency orders or regulations issued under the Mayor's emergency  
12 powers authorized by the Proclamation of Emergency; and  
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14 **WHEREAS**, having considered the impact of the emergency orders and regulations  
15 on the public health and the Anchorage economy, and the data related to the spread  
16 of COVID-19, the capability of health care services in Anchorage to handle  
17 anticipated cases, the increased ability to test, and the increased contact tracing  
18 capacity, the Assembly finds it appropriate to review the necessity of the Mayor's  
19 orders and regulations; now, therefore  
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21 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**  
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23 **Section 1.** Any of the Mayor's orders and/or regulations checked below are  
24 hereby terminated:  
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- 26  EO-04-V3 Temporarily Lifting Enforcement of Bag Fees Ordinance.  
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28  EO-08 Aligning Municipal Enforcement of Marijuana and Alcohol Code  
29 and Regulations with State Law.  
30  1. The Municipality shall not enforce any Municipal Code or  
31 regulation that prohibits curbside pickup of alcohol from  
32 restaurants, breweries, distilleries, and retail stores, as well as  
33 the delivery of sealed beer and wine from restaurants with food  
34 orders.  
35  2. The Municipality shall not enforce any Municipal Code or  
36 regulation that prohibits internet or phone sales, or exterior  
37 window or curbside pick-up of marijuana or marijuana products.  
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39  EO-10 Phase Three: Maintenance.  
40  1. Everyone currently in the Municipality is strongly recommended  
41 to limit physical contact with those outside their household and a  
42 small chosen group of other individuals.  
43  2. Anyone particularly at-risk should take greater precautions: stay

at home, not go to work, and not do their own shopping.  
Household members of those at elevated risk should implement these more stringent guidelines as well.

- 3. Individuals likely to be contagious with COVID-19 required to reduce contact with others even further.
- 4. All businesses, services, and entities are eligible to operate if they can follow the health mandates that apply to Phase Three operations. Operating criteria (not mandatory for businesses previously identified as "critical" in EO-09) attachments:
  - a. Attachment A: Most Businesses
  - b. Attachment B: Personal Care Services Safety Criteria
  - c. Attachment C: Fitness and Gyms Safety Criteria
  - d. Attachment D: Social, Religious, and Other Gatherings
  - e. Attachment E: Child Care Safety Criteria
  - f. Attachment F: Day Camps Safety Criteria
- 5. All gatherings must follow six-foot physical distancing and proper hygiene protocols. Large events of over 500 people are not permitted without advanced permission.
- 6. Nothing in the Order shall require use of a mask or cloth face covering for certain persons if contrary to his or her health or safety because of a medical condition; disability; child in a childcare setting; child under age of 2 years; or an older child if person responsible is unable to place the mask safely on the child's face.

- EO-11 International and Interstate Travel.
- EO-12 Temporary Expansion of Licensed Premises for Onsite Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages.
- EO-13-v2 Requirement for Masks or Cloth Faced Coverings.
- EO-14-v2 Return to Modified Version of Phase Two: Gathering Limits, Capacity Limitations at Bars, Restaurants, Gyms, and More.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
