5 ACQUISITION AND APPROPRIATING NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION THREE  
6 HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,300,000) OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAIL  
7 SALES TAX FUND (206000) FUND BALANCE AS A TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATING  
8 SAID TRANSFER ~~[AND APPROPRIATING TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000), WHEN~~  
9 ~~TENDERED, AS A RESTRICTED CONTRIBUTION ALL]~~ TO THE AREAWIDE GENERAL

14 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

15  
16 **Section 1.** That the sum of Not to Exceed Four Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars  
17 (\$4,900,000) is reappropriated from previously appropriated funds on AO 2020-99, As  
18 Amended for property acquisition, within the Areawide General Capital Improvement Projects  
19 Fund (401800), Maintenance & Operations Department to be used for construction of an adult  
20 shelter and/or navigation center.

21  
22 **Section 2.** That the sum of Not to Exceed One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars  
23 (\$1,300,000) of Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000) fund balance is  
24 appropriated as a transfer and appropriating said transfer to the Areawide General Capital  
25 Improvement Projects Fund (401800), Maintenance & Operations Department to be used for  
26 construction of an adult shelter and/or navigation center.

27  
28 ~~**Section 3.** That the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) of restricted~~  
29 ~~contribution revenue is appropriated to the Areawide General Capital Improvement~~  
30 ~~Projects Fund (401800), Maintenance & Operations Department to be used for~~  
31 ~~construction of an adult shelter and/or navigation center.]~~

33 **Section 3. [4.]** That this resolution shall take effect upon approval by the Anchorage Municipal  
34 Assembly.

 7 **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (CIP) FUND (401800) PREVIOUSLY**  
 8 **APPROPRIATED ON AO 2020-99, AS AMENDED FOR PROPERTY**  
 9 **ACQUISITION AND APPROPRIATING NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION**  
 10 **THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,300,000) OF ALCOHOLIC**  
 11 **BEVERAGES RETAIL SALES TAX FUND (206000) FUND BALANCE AS A**  
 12 **TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATING SAID TRANSFER [AND**  
 13 **APPROPRIATING TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000), WHEN**  
 14 **TENDERED, AS A RESTRICTED CONTRIBUTION ALL] TO THE AREAWIDE**  
 15 **GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FUND (401800)**  
 16 **MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT, TO BE USED FOR**  
 17 **CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADULT SHELTER AND/OR NAVIGATION CENTER.**

19 The attached S version of resolution AR 2022-111 includes the following:

20  
21 Changing the total appropriation amount from \$8,200,000 to \$6,200,000 by deleting the  
 22 \$2,000,000 appropriation from the Alaska Community Foundation (ACF).

23  
24 The change is due to the ability for the check to be issued directly by ACF for payment toward  
 25 the Adult Shelter and/or Navigation Center structure as previously approved by the Assembly.

26  
27 To date, a \$50,000 contract has been awarded to Roger Hickel Contracting through the  
 28 competitive process for construction management. In accordance with Title 7 section 7.15.040,  
 29 Assembly approval was not required.

30  
31 With a focus on the need for the Adult Shelter/Navigation Center to be operational before the  
 32 Sullivan shelter's June 30, 2022 closure, the Municipality is using a project delivery method  
 33 process called Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC) that accelerates the design  
 34 and construction process, shortens a project's timeline, and reduces costs. Use of a CMGC  
 35 process for a separate project was approved by the Assembly (AM 353-2020) on June 23, 2020.

36  
37 The Municipality currently is in negotiations for the project's construction. The results from this  
 38 process in terms of a contract award will come before the Assembly once the CM/GC process  
 39 is complete.
