AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PROVIDING FINANCIAL RESOURCES FOR LABOR, SUPPLIES, AND OTHER EXPENDITURES REQUIRED TO ADDRESS MUNICIPAL RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE AREAWIDE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (CIP) FUND (401800), PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR PROPERTY ACQUISITION BY AO 2020-99, AS AMENDED, AND NOW REAPPROPRIATED TO THE COVID-19 FUND (231802), AND PROVIDING A PLAN FOR FUTURE REIMBURSEMENT OF SAID REAPPROPRIATION.

WHEREAS, at 2:30 p.m. on March 12, 2020, pursuant to authority granted in Article V, Section 5.02 of the Home Rule Charter for the Municipality of Anchorage and AMC 3.80.040, the Mayor declared that a civil emergency existed within the Municipality of Anchorage based upon the events and circumstances specified above; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly approved emergency ordinance appropriations totaling \$87,808,189 and non-emergency appropriations totaling \$25,663,780.57 for COVID-19 response expenses; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 10.03, in the event of such an emergency, an ordinance may be introduced and adopted by the Assembly at the same meeting, provided the Assembly makes a finding in the ordinance that an emergency exists and provides a statement of the facts constituting the emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality is pursuing State and Federal assistance that, if and to the extent received, will be used to fully reimburse the costs of protecting the public safety, health, and welfare of the Municipality of Anchorage from COVID-19; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Charter Section 10.03, the Assembly hereby specifically finds that COVID-19 resulted in a documented civil emergency within the Municipality of Anchorage. The Assembly further finds that an emergency now requires immediate appropriation of funds for labor, supplies, and other expenditures. Failure to immediately address these issues will result in an insufficiency of services or facilities substantial enough to endanger the public health, safety, or welfare.

<u>Section 2.</u> The sum of not to exceed FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) is hereby reappropriated from the Areawide General Capital Improvements Projects (CIP) Fund (401800), Real Estate Department, as a contribution to the COVID-19 Fund (231802) for COVID-19 congregate emergency shelter services at the Sullivan

Arena for a period of performance of January 1, 2022 through March 31, 2022.
<u>Section 3.</u> This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
